




Q2 2023

179,042 new registrations were recorded in Q2 2023, contributing to a total of 3,703,406 .eu domain name registrations at the end of the quarter. Cyprus led the relative portfolio growth with 18%, followed by Portugal with 5.3% and Romania with 2.4%.

In the second quarter of 2023, EURid actively engaged in prominent industry events, including the Nordic Domain Days in Sweden, We Make Future in Italy, and EuroDIG in Finland. In addition, this period marked the launch of the 10th annual .eu Web Awards competition, the introduction of our innovative WebClass tool, and a celebration of youth art through our SAFEonLINE art competition.

EURid celebrated the **17th anniversary** of the .eu domain name by providing an update on the 1000 trees that have been planted over the past two years and are expected to absorb approximately 234.75 metric tons of CO₂ over their lifetime.

EURid unveiled **WebClass**, its latest innovation - **a machine learning solution** that automatically classifies web pages in any European language into predefined use categories.


JUNE 2023




MULTI-YEAR REGISTRATIONS (MYRS)

TOP 10 CENTR ccTLDs BASED ON REGISTRATIONS AS OF Q2 2023





Top growth countries Q1 2023 vs. Q2 2023 with over 1000 registrations


