Dear Registrant,

We would like to draw your attention to the European Commission's notice to .eu stakeholders (published on 28 March 2018) concerning the impact of the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union on .eu domain names registered to registrants under a GB/GI country code (see https://ec.europa.eu/digital-single-market/en/news/notice-stakeholders-withdrawal-united-kingdom-and-eu-rules-eu-domain-names).

On 30 March 2019, as of 00:00:00 CET, your .eu domain name(s) will no longer be in compliance with the .eu regulatory framework.

You will be given the opportunity to demonstrate your compliance with the .eu regulatory framework by updating your contact data (e.g. indicating a legally established entity in one of the eligible EU27 or EEA Member States, or update of residence) through your registrar (the company through which you registered the domain name) before 30 May 2019, 00:00:00 CEST. During this two-month period, your domain names will remain active except for domain names expiring in this period. Please contact your registrar for detailed information on the registration terms of your domain name(s).

As of 30 May 2019, 00:00:00 CEST, if you have not demonstrated your eligibility within the .eu regulatory framework, your domain name(s) will be WITHDRAWN. A WITHDRAWN domain name no longer functions, as it will be removed from the zone file and can no longer support any active services (such as websites or email), but its record will remain in the .eu registry database and may be reactivated if the eligibility criteria are satisfied.

On 30 March 2020 00:00:00 CET, all affected domain names will be REVOKED, and will become AVAILABLE for general registration.
